## What is it?

The Great Science Share for Schools is a fast-growing campaign to **inspire young people into science and engineering**. Taking place annually it involves young people between **5 - 14 years of age communicating their own scientific questions and investigations with new audiences**.

The theme for this year's event is the **Climate Emergency**, however, YSLs can follow other science topics that inspire them.

## How can I get involved?

There are many ways for Young STEM Leaders to get involved with the Great Science Share for Schools by planning an activity, event or interaction in their centre, at home or anywhere.

- Creating digital engagements such as videos, sharing via social media
